### In Case of Ties:

#### Case-I: For Major Courses:

- If and only if, the Index of Merit is same, then the Subject Marks in HS (or 10+2 Equivalent) Examination will be considered for ranking.
- If the Index of Merit and the Subject Marks both are same, then the Aggregate Percentage Marks (rounded up to two decimal points) of Madhyamik (or 10<sup>th</sup> Standard) Examination will be considered for ranking.

#### Case-II: For Multidisciplinary Courses:

- If the Index of Merit is same then the Aggregate Percentage Marks (rounded up to two decimal points) of Madhyamik (or 10<sup>th</sup> Standard) Examination will be considered for ranking.
